Learn About Chapter 135 and the 2026 Ballot Question

What is Chapter 135 (H4885)? Is a recently passed law in MA that dramatically changes firearm regulations in our state. While it's presented as a modernization effort, the law imposes significant restrictions on law-abiding citizens without effectively addressing violent crime. www.goal.org/gunban

Key civil rights and 2A concerns include:

- **Mandates Registration:** Requires registration of all firearms, including antique and hunting firearms.
- **Bans Non-Resident Hunters:** Prohibits hunting by non-residents under 18.
- **Creation of a Massive Database:** The state will create a massive database with every bit of information on owners, hunters, guns owned and where they live, exposing us to hackers.
- **Requires Licensing for Semi-Auto Shotguns and Rifles:** Shifts from FID cards to stricter LTC requirements, making felons of many residents.
- **Imposes Serialization Rules:** Demands serialized markings on all firearms
- **Delays and Ambiguities:** Portions of the law have been delayed or suspended, creating confusion for residents and businesses



Why Should You Care?

- **Constitutional Rights:** Chapter 135 threatens your Second Amendment rights and sets a dangerous precedent for other civil liberties. Imagine an Act of Modernizing Freedom of Speech or Religion? A Database of people who exercise certain constitutional rights?
- **Impact on Communities:** The law disproportionately affects urban areas, financially struggling residents, and lawful gun owners who follow the rules.
- **Government Overreach:** This law represents an overreach, targeting law-abiding citizens while failing to address the root causes of crime.

What is the Ballot Question About? Our grassroots coalition, **The Civil Rights Coalition**, has gathered over 95,000 certified signatures to bring Chapter 135 to a statewide vote in **November 2026**. This referendum is your opportunity to decide whether this law should remain or be repealed.
